

**IETE MEANS- CUM-MERIT SCHOLARSHIP SCHEME FOR  
AMIETE AND DipIETE STUDENTS**

**1. The Scheme:**

1.1 The Institution of Electronics and Telecommunication Engineers (IETE), founded in 1953, is today a leading professional society devoted to the advancement of science & Technology of Electronics, Telecommunication, Computers and Information Technology. It serves more than 62,000 members both individuals and industry or organizations through its 57 Centres/ Sub-Centres spread all over India including one in Kathmandu, Nepal.

1.2 IETE has voluntarily adopted socially relevant and progressive programmes especially aimed at the weaker and underprivileged sections of the society. IETE is rendering a yeoman's service in spreading the technical education to every nook and corner of the country. It is endeavouring to empower the students from the weaker section of the society from all over India including the inaccessible, remote and rural areas by imparting quality technical education at very affordable cost. Furthering our social responsibilities & obligations to the society, the IETE is launching from financial year 2010-11 a means-cum-merit scholarship scheme for its undergraduate and diploma students.

1.3 Under the scheme, 100 annual scholarships to the meritorious and economically weaker students of AMIETE and DipIETE will be awarded. Out of these 50 scholarships will be for AMIETE students and 50 for DipIETE. The scholarships will be open to all the eligible IETE students of AMIETE and DipIETE from all over India meeting the laid down eligibility criteria. The amount of scholarship will be Rs.5, 000/- per student in a year. Every year fresh applications will be required from the students for the scholarship for that year meeting the eligibility criteria.

**2. Eligibility Criteria:**

2.1 The eligibility criteria for applying for scholarship will be as under:

(a) The total family income should be less than Rs.2 lacs per year. The family income includes the income of both the parents and self. Those students who are selected for award of scholarship will be required to furnish

the income certificate from District Magistrate at the time of disbursement of the scholarship.

(b) If the applicant falls in BPL category, the photocopy of the BPL certificate and Ration card should be attached with application.

(c) The applicant should meet the criteria in one of the category mentioned in Para 3 below.

(d) A student already in receipt of scholarship in one category is eligible to apply only for the next or subsequent category of the scholarship in next or subsequent year. For example a recipient of scholarship under A1 category can apply for scholarship under A2 or A3 category in the next or subsequent years.

### **3. Category of Scholarship:**

3.1 The scholarship will be granted in the following categories:

#### **(a) AMIETE Students**

##### **Category:**

**A1** 25 scholarships will be awarded to the students who have appeared for all theory papers of Sec A Part I and have scored a Grade Point Average (GPA) of 6.0 or above in the best of 3 papers passed.

**A2** 15 scholarships will be awarded to the students who have appeared for all theory papers of Sec A Part II and have scored a Grade Point Average (GPA) of 6.0 or above in the best of 3 papers passed.

**A3** 10 scholarships will be awarded to the students who have appeared for all theory papers of Sec B Part I and have scored a Grade Point Average (GPA) of 6.0 or above in the best of 3 papers passed

#### **(b) DipIETE Students**

##### **Category:**

**D1** 25 scholarships will be awarded to the students who have appeared for all theory papers of Sec A Part I and have scored a Grade Point Average (GPA) of 6.0 or above in the best of 3 papers passed.

**D2** 15 scholarships will be awarded to the students who have appeared for all theory papers of Sec A Part II and have scored a Grade Point Average (GPA) of 6.0 or above in the best of 3 papers passed.

**D3** 10 scholarships will be awarded to the students who have appeared for all theory papers of Sec B Part I and have scored a Grade Point Average (GPA) of 6.0 or above in the best of 3 papers passed

**(b)** The best papers shall also include the papers cleared after improvement.

**4. Application Form:**

4.1 Application form as per format attached at **Appendix-‘A**, duly filled along with relevant certificates should be sent to IETE HQ by 15 Jun of every year on the following address:

4.3 Incomplete applications received will not be considered.

**5. Procedure for processing of Applications :**

5.1 IETE HQ will prepare the list of applicants and process the applications received for consideration of the Scholarship Award Committee. The selection of the scholarship awardees will be strictly on means-cum-merit basis and will be finalized by end of July every year. The scholarship awardees will be intimated individually as well as through web in Jul/Aug every year.

6.1 The IETE Standing Scholarship Awards Committee will be as under:-

**8. Rules & Regulations governing the Scheme:**

8.1 The scheme will be operational from the financial year 2010-11.

8.2 All rules and regulations governing this scheme are subject to change from time to time as reviewed by the IETE, and shall be binding on all the awardees.

IETE is pleased to announce the institution of IETE Means-Cum-Merit Scholarship Scheme for AMIETE and DipIETE Students as per decision of Council in its 4<sup>th</sup> (2009-10) meeting. The scheme envisages award of 100 annual scholarships, 50 each to AMIETE and DipIETE economical weaker and meritorious students. The amount of scholarship will be Rs.5000/- per student in a year.

This scheme comes into effect from the financial year 2010-11. Last date for receipt of duly completed applications at IETE HQ is 15 Jun 2010 and names of awardees of scholarship will be announced by 31 Jul 2010.
