Government Departments equivalent to BE/B.Tech**


Dear Sir,

6. The students passed out from IETE are working in higher positions in Govt Departments (Defence Forces, DRDO, ISRO, BSNL, Railways, CSIR, Doordarshan and All India Radio), Educational Institutions and Industry in India and Abroad.
7. We are also enclosing herewith a list containing the recognitions received from MHRD, UPSC, IITs and Universities which have recognised this course, for your ready reference.
