Sukanya Samridhi Yojna (SSY):

This scheme was launched by Narendra Modi. The aim of this scheme is to meet the education and marriage expenses of a girl child. All the provisions were explained in detail.

Digital Transaction:

How to do all the types of digital transactions and their benefits were explained. Use of the cashless transaction and their features were disclosed. Use of ATM's and credit cards was explained.

Financial security of women:

The schemes that are developed for women by the government were familiarize to them. how can the women be independent and be financially secure was explained. The special schemes available in the banks were informed.

Use of apps for payment and recharge:

They introduced BHIM app and PAYTM app and even explained how to use them. They also described the yojanas that are introduced for women benefits.
