CASUAL VACANCIES

A casual vacancy cannot be for more than 46. one year. Any casual vacancy arising in the Governing Council for less than one year shall not be filled. Casual vacancies so arising during the year may be filled by the Governing Council from amongst those contestants who were not elected, but obtained the next largest number of votes in the last election to the Governing Council. In the case of vacancies arising from amongst the office bearers, except that of the President, the President shall, in consultation with the Governing Council, nominate a member to fill the vacancy from amongst its elected members.

46. Any casual vacancy arising during the year shall not be filled.

PROCEEDINGS & MEETINGS

80. The quorum at any Annual, Extraordinary or Special General Meeting shall be fifty of those persons entitled to be present and vote thereat and no business shall be transacted at any such meeting unless the quorum be present at the commencement of the business. If a quorum be not present within half an hour from the time appointed for the meeting, the meeting shall be adjourned, and the adjourned meeting can assemble after 2-4 weeks, the date for which will be given to all the Corporate members. No quorum is necessary at any adjourned meeting.

PROCEEDINGS & MEETINGS

80. The quorum at any Annual, Extraordinary or Special General Meeting shall be fifty of those persons entitled to be present and vote thereat and no business shall be transacted at any such meeting unless the quorum be present at the commencement of the business. If a quorum is not present at the time appointed for the meeting, the meeting will be adjourned, and the adjourned meeting can reassemble after 30 minutes. No quorum is necessary at the reassembled meeting.
