

1. MEMBERSHIP

The membership of the Institution continued to grow and recorded an increase of 1,027 members. The total number of members of all classes on the 30th September 1963 was 4,013 of whom 373 were Corporate members. The Table I below shows the growth of various categories of members since the inception of the Institution.

1,265 applications were received by the Membership Committee during the year and 1,028 new members were elected and 1,023 joined the Institution. Five women members were admitted to the Institution bringing the number of women members to 15 in all classes. (Associate members—2, Graduates—2 and Student members—11).

The list of Corporate and Graduate members of the Institution as on 30th September 1963 is given in the Part II of the Report. Members are requested to kindly intimate to the secretariate any change in their address or qualifications for necessary correction.

The Council wish to thank the Membership Committee for their arduous and complicated task in the selection of various categories of the members during the year.

Every year the Institution is faced with the lapse of membership subscriptions even after repeated reminders. No body wishes to be in arrears intentionally but somehow the payment of the membership fee in due time has perhaps escaped the attention of the members. This year also the number of members in arrears is

quite large. The number of members in arrears for one year is 853 and two years is 296. All the members are once again appealed to ensure prompt payment. To help the members whose names have been deleted from the membership the Council have decided that such members can be readmitted in the same class to which they belonged by paying the admission fee and the current year's membership subscription fee. The Council wish to draw the attention of the members to this particular point.

2. JOURNALS

The Journal has maintained its steady progress and is now recognised as one of the important technical periodicals in the field of telecommunication. The highlight of this year is that of converting the bimonthly into a monthly issue from August 1963. With this, the Council hope to include greater number of articles on technological and scientific research in the country. In addition in July 1963 the Institution, in co-operation with the Central Electronic Engineering Research Institute, Pilani brought out a special issue on "Electronic Devices" as arising from the papers read at the proceedings of the special symposium on "Electronic Devices" held in December 1962 at Pilani.

The Editorial Committee invites specialists to contribute review papers on certain subjects where a large amount of research work has already been done. Such papers are very useful for reference purpose as they are complete with up-to-date bibliography and also give a connected account of the present state of knowledge on the subject.

The number of papers published in the Journal of the Institution during the year was 51 compared to 35 in the year 1961-62.

The Journal is supplied to all the members of the Institution free of charge. The copies of the Journal supplied are given below :

Students' Quarterly Journal is another important publication of the Institution, which is meant to cater to the needs of the beginners in the profession and students in particular, for supplementing their studies in preparing for the Graduateship Examination. The Journal which contains technical papers, books reviews etc. is widely read and appreciated. Non-student members have also begun to show keen interest in this Journal. The subscription rate for the non-student members is Rs. 5. The contributors to the Students' Quarterly Journal are paid an honorarium.

The Council appreciate the work carried out by the Editorial Committee in converting the bimonthly journal into a monthly one and making the publications of the Institution a great success. A list of papers that have been published in the Journal of the Institution and the Students' Journal are given in the Part II of the Report.

The cost of producing the Journal has been mounting steadily and the Council are aiming to obtain a greater advertisement revenue to set against the increased costs. The total number of advertisement pages printed in the Journal of the Institution during the year 1962-63 was 156 compared to 122 in the year 1961-62. The revenue received from advertisements during the year was Rs. 11,350 compared to Rs. 7,512 in the year 1961-62.

The Advertisement position of the Journal of the Institution has considerably improved. This has been undoubtedly due to the efforts of the Editorial Committee and in particular to their distinguished Chairman, Dr. P.K. Kapre.

The Council also wish to express their thanks to the various organisations who have taken up space for advertisement in the Journals. The Council take this opportunity to request all the Radio and Electronic firms in India and abroad to utilise the space of the Journals for advertising their products. This will not only serve the interests of advertisers but also the professional telecommunication engineers in the country and abroad will be informed of the new products in electronic and allied subjects. It will also assist the Journal in making it financially self-supporting.

3. I.T.E. AWARD

The contributions published in the journal are being widely read and abstracted all over the world. To encourage greater number of leading research workers to send their contributions to the Journal, the Council decided to make an award of Rs. 500 to the best contributor of original research paper. This award is presented at the Annual General Meeting of the Institution. The Council hope that this incentive would encourage young generation of engineers and scientists in India to undertake valuable original work and to contribute their papers to the Journal of the Institution. The I.T.E. Award is open to members as well as to non-members.

The third award for the year 1962 was awarded to Dr. C.S.G.K. Setty, Reader in Radiophysics and Electronics in the University of Delhi for his paper on "Observations of Ionospheric F Layer at Night" which appeared in the January and March 1961 issues of the Journal of the Institution. Hearty congratulations are accorded to Dr. C.S.G.K. Setty for his valuable contribution. The citation is

4. EXAMINATIONS

An important milestone in the progress of the Institution has been holding Graduateship Examination twice a year in May and November. It is hoped that this examination will lead to the wide acceptance of its being a major qualifying route for professional telecommunication engineers. These examinations were being held at Agra, Bangalore, Bombay, Calcutta, Delhi, Ernakulam, Jabalpur, Madras and Poona. There were many requests from student members of the Institution in and around Hyderabad and Lucknow for opening centres for the examination at these two places. The Council considered these requests and opened additional examination centres at Hyderabad and Lucknow during the year.

The Council also amended the Examination Regulations 11 and para 4 of 12 of the Graduateship Examination during the year.

Existing Regulation 11 :

"Candidates intending to sit for Graduateship Examination consisting of two sections—Section A and Section B may appear for both sections in one sitting subject to Regulation 5. Candidates desiring to take the Sections in two or more sittings should complete Section A before taking Section B. Candidates may also be permitted to appear for one or more parts of Section A at one sitting".

Revised Regulation 11 :

"Candidates intending to sit for Graduateship Examination consisting of two sections—Section A and Section B may appear for one or both Sections in one sitting subject to Regulation 5. Candidates may also be permitted to appear for one or more parts of Section A at one sitting".

Existing Regulation 12, Para 4 :

"When a candidate takes both Sections A and B simultaneously, subject to Regulation 5, and passes in Section B and fails in Section A he will be permitted to complete Section A at subsequent examinations".

Revised Regulation 12, Para 4 :

"When a candidate takes both Sections A and B simultaneously, subject to Regulation 5, passes in Section B and fails in Section A, he will be required to pass Section A within five years, of passing Section B in order to be declared to have passed the Graduateship examination.

The Council also revised the list of referees and made it more broad based. The list of referees is published in the Part II of the Report.

In the year under review examinations were held in November 1962 and May 1963.

The number of candidates taking examination has increased. Table II shows steady growth in the number of candidates who are taking up the Graduateship Examination of I.T.E.

There is a large number of candidates who have passed the Graduateship examination in parts.

The Council gratefully thank the Examination Committee for the considerable spade work such as selection of examiners, moderation of question papers and marks and declaration of the results of the two examinations. In this connection, the Council wish to thank the Chairman and the Honorary Secretary of each local centre, the professors of many colleges, universities and technological institutes and members of the profession for help in conducting the examination.

It has been observed that the percentage of student members successful in passing Graduateship Examination is low. The Council is already seized with this problem and have various measures regarding training facilities under active consideration.

It is gratifying to note that the Ministry of Defence has made a good start in imparting part-time training to the Students who are preparing for the Grad. I.T.E. Examination. This is a significant step towards assisting persons in the profession to achieve academic standards. The tutorial colleges for such training have now been functioning at Bangalore, Bombay, Delhi, Jabalpur and Poona.

The Council express their warmest thanks to the Ministry of Defence and their Staff at these tutorial Colleges for their good work during the past year in support of the Institution's programme of activities.

Studentship award

The Council has decided to give studentship Award to the value of Rs. 100 to the candidate who is adjudged as having the best performance in both the subjects of Section B. It is hoped that this award will encourage candidates to show outstanding performance. The first award will be made after the final examination of November 1963 and will continue to be awarded for each examination.

5. LIBRARY

A well equipped library of its own is a boon to any professional Institution. With the kind assistance received from the Ministry of S.R. & C.A. the Institution is able to initially build up the library to meet the needs of our members. Institution has supplied a set of text books to local centres and to telecommunication tutorial college, New Delhi. This arrangement will to some extent meet the requirements of students members in their studies for Grad. I.T.E. Examination.

During the year under review, 1,700 books on telecommunication engineering and allied subjects were added to the library bringing the total to 2,000. The library also contains dictionaries, encyclopedia, reference books etc. Apart from the books there are 700 bound journals. The Institution also received 98 leading journals throughout the world in exchange with the journal of the institution. The list of these Journals is published in the Part II of the Report.

6. BUILDING

Negotiations are in progress with the Institution of Town Planners for owning three floors in the proposed multistoried building which they propose to construct in Indra Prastha Estate and with the Ministry of Education for obtaining appropriate grant for the purpose.

Simultaneously steps have also been taken to get an allotment of a suitable land from Delhi Land and Development Authorities for constructing a building for the Institution.

7. STAFF AND ACCOMMODATION

The office of the Institution is housed in F/12, South Extension Part II, Ring Road, New Delhi-16.

The accommodation even now, is inadequate to meet the growing requirements of library, reading room and office. The Council hope to move the secretariat into another building which will serve more effectively the needs and activities of the Institution.

Calcutta, Jabalpur, Madras and Poona. These centres provide members in such areas with the opportunity of taking a direct part in an Institution activity. The Council record their appreciation of the work that Chairmen and Secretaries at these centres did in arranging lectures and discussions, promoting drive for new members and conducting Grad. I.T.E. Examination.

9. NINTH ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

The ninth Annual General Meeting of the Institution of Telecommunication Engineers was held at Manak Bhavan, Mathura Road, New Delhi on 7th December 1962. Shri Jagjivan Ram, the then Union Minister for Transport and Communica-tion, inaugurated the function.

Dr. Lal C. Verman, in his Welcome Address pointed out the progress made in membership, examination, library and other local activities. He announced that the Institution has decided to contribute its modest share by investing from its Reserve a sum of Rs. 30,000 in the National Defence Bonds.

Shri Jagdeesh Prasad, Member, P & T Board was then installed as the President by the retiring President Dr. Lal C. Verman. Shri Jagjivan Ram, in his address emphasized the importance of communication in the day-to-day life, more so, the importance of telecommunication engineering has assumed now, in the context of emergency. He stressed the importance of research both fundamental and applied. He added that a proper approach for research problems, healthy competition and independent thinking were, essential for any investigation to succeed. He was therefore happy to see that a start had been made by the Institution in this direction.

Shri Jagdeesh Prasad, the President, then addressed the meeting. He surveyed the various developments in the field of telecommunications in the country and outlined the present position in this field covered by the P & T Department. The meeting was concluded, with a vote of thanks by Shri C.P. Vasudevan, Director, Telecommunication Research Centre, P & T Directorate, New Delhi.

10. SIXTH TECHNICAL CONVENTION

The Sixth Technical Convention of the I.T.E. was held on 8th and 9th December, 1962. The technical convention was attended by Engineers and Scientists from Civil Aviation Department, New Delhi ; College of Engineering and Technology, New Delhi ; National Physical Laboratory, New Delhi ; Birla College of Engineering, Pilani ; Ministry of Defence, New Delhi ; Central Electronics Engineering Research Institute, Pilani ; Institute of Armament Studies, Poona ; All India Radio, New Delhi ; Indian Institute of Technology, Madras ; Tata Institute of Fundamental Research, Bombay and Ministry of Scientific Research & Cultural Affairs, New Delhi. Shri Vasudevan gave an informative review of the forthcoming developments in micro-wave communication system shortly to be introduced by the P. & T. Department.

The first session was devoted to papers on Microwave electronics and electronic systems. Shri C.P. Vasudevan, Director, Telecommunication Research Centre, Posts and Telegraphs, New Delhi presided over the session. In this session five papers were presented out of which three were from the National Physical Laboratory, New Delhi ; one each from the College of Engineering and Technology, New Delhi and the Research Department of All India Radio.

The second session of the Convention consisted of subjects on Acoustics, Audio Engineering and Systems Engineering. Dr. N.B. Bhatt, Director, Solid State

Physics Laboratory, Defence Research and Development Organisation, New Delhi was the Chairman. In all nine papers were presented of which three were from All India Radio, New Delhi, two from the Defence Research and Development Organisation, New Delhi and one each from the Ministry of Defence, Central Electronics Engineering Research Institute, Pilani, Institute of Armament Studies, Poona and the Civil Aviation Department, New Delhi.

The third session covered the subjects pertaining to Ionospheric propagation and Space Communication and was presided over by Shri Jagdeesh Prasad, Member (Telecommunication Development), P & T Board, New Delhi.

The fourth and final session of the convention was presided over by Shri T.V. Ramamurthi, Officer-on-Special Duty, National Physical Laboratory, New Delhi. This session covered yet another important field in telecommunication Engineering, namely vacuum tubes, solid state devices, line communication, radar beacon, direction finder and receivers.

Another feature of the Technical Convention was the exhibitions of Electronic components and test equipment. The following were the participants in the exhibition : 1. Associated Instrument Manufacturers Private Ltd., New Delhi ; 2. Eastern Electronics, Faridabad ; 3. Toshniwal Bros. Private Ltd., Bombay ; 4. Bharat Electronics Ltd. The Institution is grateful to all those who helped to participate in the exhibition and for demonstrating various test equipment manufactured in India.
