





INTRODUCTION

It is with great pleasure that the Council of the Institution of Telecommunication Engineers presents the 15th Annual Report of the Institution. The Institution has made considerable progress during the year 1967-68. The membership of the Institution has gone upto 7170 as on the 30th September, 1968. The Grad. I. T. E. Examination continues to be popular with 4981 candidates appearing during the year. 270 have been declared successful and the Graduateship diplomas issued to them. 64 papers have been published in the Journal of the Institution. A notable feature is the publication of this journal early in the month of its issue. Local centres of the Institution at Bangalore, Bombay, Calcutta, Jabalpur and Madras increased their activities throughout the year. Bangalore and Delhi had special programmes for the students. The Council is aware of the problems facing the students desirous of appearing in the Grad. I.T.E. Examination and steps have been taken to provide the necessary facilities.

The financial position continues to be sound with the total assets exceeding Rs. eight lakhs.

The details of the activities of the Institution in various fields are given in this Annual Report.

It will be seen from the above table that ever since 1959 when the graduation examination of the Institution was recognized by the Government and the Union Public Service Commission, there has been a steep increase in the category of Student membership. It is hoped that in the years to come more and more members will join the Institution in the other categories of membership too.

A close survey of the composition of the membership indicates that a large percentage of members belong to public sector and Government departments. It is our sincere desire that Telecommunication and Electronic engineers working in private sector undertakings as also in laboratories and teaching establishments would join the Institution and take active part in its growth. It is only when the electronic and telecommunication engineers from both the private and public sector and in the laboratories and engineering colleges join our Institution that the Institution can be truly representative in all its aspects.

During the year, the Membership Committee considered and recommended to the Council the acceptance of 1763 applications for members and 188 applications for transfer to higher grades. Of the total, 56 were for the entry into Corporate grades, 2 into the Associateship, 241 into Graduates and 1464 into students. The list of Corporate members as on the 30th September, 1968 is included in Part-II of this Report.

Members are requested to pay their dues in the month of October every year and to intimate any change in their addresses or qualifications to the Secretariat for correction in the official records of the Institution.

Every year, the Institution has to write off a large amount of money due to failure on the part of certain members to pay their membership dues even after repeated reminders. We are aware that nobody wishes to be a defaulter intentionally but paying membership subscription in due time has somehow escaped the attention of some members. We once again appeal to all the members to ensure prompt payment and spare us of this unpleasant duty of withholding the supply of the journal or striking their names off the rolls in accordance with Bye-laws 28 and 29.

Fellows :

The Council takes great pleasure in announcing the election of Shri S. S. Aiyar, Chief Engineer, All India Radio; and Dr. N. B. Bhatt, Director, Solidstate Physics Laboratory, distinguished members of the Institution and of the profession, as Fellows of the Institution during the year 1967-68.



EXAMINATION

The Graduateship Examination of the Institution retained its popularity as candidates who pass the Grade. I.T.E. Examination can be considered for recruitment to posts in superior engineering services as recognised by the Union Public Service Commission. The Examination, after a modest beginning in 1959 with only 22 candidates, had the privilege of having 2479 candidates in November 1967 and 2501 in May, 1968 Grade. I.T.E. Examinations. (Total number of successful candidates was 270). Nearly 3000 candidates are expected to take up the examination in November, 1968.

These examinations are now, being held at eighteen centres throughout India, namely at Agra, Ahmedabad, Bangalore, Bombay, Calcutta, Chandigarh, Delhi, Ernakulam, Gauhati, Hyderabad, Jabalpur, Jaipur, Lucknow, Madras, Nagpur, Poona, Srinagar and Trivandrum ; Chandigarh and Srinagar having been recently started. Rajkot centre was shifted to Ahmedabad from May-1968.

According to Regulation 5 of the Examination Regulations, candidates wishing to appear for Section 'B' of Grad. I.T.E. Examination should have had five years of experience in technical capacity or should produce an Eligibility Certificate from one of the Referees (appointed by the Council), that he has prosecuted and engaged himself in the engineering profession for an aggregate period of not less than 24 months. Accordingly a system of Refereeship has been introduced for the benefit of those candidates who do not possess an experience of five years in the field of telecommunication engineering. The list of Referees is given in Appendix-IV of the Report. Candidates are advised, in their own interest, to register themselves with the referees early after becoming student members of the Institution. It is incorrect to communicate with referees through letters and answer their queries on the subject matter of their study through correspondence.

It has been observed that the percentage of student members successful in passing the Grad. I.T.E. examination is still low. The Council is seized of this problem and has taken various steps including facilities for training. The Ministry of Defence is continuing to conduct courses for the students who are preparing for the Grad. I.T.E. Examination. Tutorial Colleges for such training are a regular feature with great success at Bangalore, Bombay Delhi and Poona. The Council is grateful to the Ministry of Defence and their staff at the above Tutorial Colleges for their valuable assistance. Constructive suggestions to improve the present facilities offered will be appreciated. This should be forwarded to the Secretary of the Institution at 72-Ring Road, Lajpat Nagar-III, New Delhi-24.

There has been a phenomenal progress in recent years in the field of electronics, specially in Control Engineering and Computer Engineering. The Examination Committee recommended inclusion of two more papers ; e.g. Control Engineering and Computer Engineering in Section 'B' of Grad. I.T.E. Examination. The Council has accepted this recommendation along with a paper on "Electronic Measurements." With this addition, the number of papers in Section 'B' is now 13.

The Examination Committee also revised the syllabus for the paper on Applied Electronics & Circuits—Part-II, Section-A of Grad. I.T.E. Examination in step with recent developments.

The Council takes this opportunity of thanking the Chairman and Honorary Secretaries of the various Local Centres, as well as heads of many Colleges, Universities, Technical Institutions, and members of the profession for their co-operation and facilities extended to the Institution in conducting the examination at their respective centres.

STUDENTSHP AWARD

In the year 1963, the Council decided to give studentship award of the value of Rs. 100/- to a candidate who secures the highest first class marks in both the papers of Section 'B' in the first attempt thus completing the Grad. EXEMPTIONS

The Examination Committee in their 36th meeting held on the 4th April, 1966 appointed a sub-committee to consider fresh exemptions already granted by the Institution to various qualified persons.

In order to facilitate the work, the Secretariat obtained recent Syallabii and question papers for the last three years (subject and year wise) from various Engineering Colleges, I.I.T.'s Universities, and Boards of Technical Education, throughout India for the detailed consideration by the sub-committee appointed for the purpose.

Revised exemption will come into force with effect from May-69 Grad. I.T.E. Examination. Candidates who complete Section-A by November-68 as per current exemptions will be deemed to have passed Section A and will be required to pass Section B only to complete the Grad. I.T.E. Examination. Candidates who have completed Section B papers but have failed to qualify in Section A by November, 1968 will be governed by the revised exemptions coming into force from May-69.

JOURNAL

The Institution is publishing two journals entitled 'Journal of the Institution of Telecommunication Engineers' and 'Students Journal'.

The Journal of the Institution of Telecommunication Engineers, a monthly, publishes observations and researches in the telecommunication as well as allied fields. The Journal of the Institution of Telecommunication Engineers started in March 1955 as a quarterly publication up to September 1959. From December 1959 it was made a bimonthly till June 1963. From July 1963 it was made a monthly publication. 64 papers were published in the year under review. The list of papers published in Journal of the Institution is given in Appendix I of this Report. Due to the untiring efforts of the Editorial Committee, it has now been made possible to make available this Journal early in the month of its issue.

Students' Journal, a quarterly, started in December 1959. It caters to the needs of student members of the Institution in supplementing their studies for the Grad. I. T. E. Examination. The articles published in the journal cover the scope of syllabus of the Graduateship Examination of the Institution. The Students' Journal has gained its popularity within a very short period after its publication. This is evident from the fact that a large number of persons other than student members are subscribing to this quarterly. The Council also invites specialists to contribute papers to the Students' Journal of the Institution so that the benefit of specialised knowledge is made available to the student members of the Institution and helps them to prepare for the Graduateship Examination. Late publication of the March, June-September 1968 issues is regretted.

The Council wishes to express its thanks to various Universities, Research Laboratories and Libraries in this country and abroad who have been continuously subscribing to the Journals of the Institution and to many Electronic and Radio Industries in India and abroad, who have been advertising their products in these journals.



FOURTEENTH ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

The Fourteenth Annual General Meeting of the Institution of Telecommunication Engineers (India) was held on the afternoon of 8 December 1967 at the Mavalankar Auditorium, Vithalbhai Patel House, New Delhi. Dr. S. Bhagavantam, Scientific Adviser to Minister of Defence, Delhi, inaugurated the session.

Dr. P. K. Kapre, Industrial Director, Philips India Ltd., New Delhi, welcoming the Chief Guest said : "We are particularly privileged this year to have in our midst this afternoon, Dr. Bhagavantam who has so kindly consented to inaugurate our Annual Session, despite very heavy calls on his time." He mentioned that our Institution had been honoured by him last year, by accepting the Honorary fellowship.

Before ending the address, he extended the heartiest congratulations to Air Vice Marshal K. A. Joseph, the Director of Signals, Air Headquarters, on his unanimous election as the President for the year 1967-68.

Dr. Bhagavantam in his inaugural address said : "It is a great honour to be called upon to be the chief guest and inaugurate this particular Annual Session of an organization like the Institution of Telecommunication Engineers (India). I sincerely feel it that you have gone out of your way to invite me firstly to become an Honorary Fellow of the Institution and then to come and be the chief guest and inaugurate the Fourteenth Annual Meeting—not that I am not used to being invited to do such things in respect of organization with which I have no contact, both happens—but that the Institution of Telecommunication Engineers should have opened its door to accept a man of my training which is not in any case specially telecommunications, but is only distantly connected with it.

In view of the growing importance of electronics and thus increasing responsibilities with the telecommunication engineers he said : "The plea I am making is that since some of you, many of you come from Universities, technological institutions and so on, some of you have the responsibility for building up the base necessary for meeting such requirements. The Institution should give an urgent thought to building up the institutions where such specialized technology can possibly be built up. It cannot be built up in a routine production concern, which is constantly worried about showing production figures. It will have to be built up. I am talking of this sophisticated technology. The base does not exist. We will have to give some thought to a thing like this."

Air Vice Marshal K. A. Joseph in his Presidential address discussed briefly the development in the field of Military Aviation Electronics, starting from humble beginnings to the present day highly sophisticated electronic systems together with some of the future trends.

Shri S. S. Aiyar, Chief Engineer, All India Radio, New Delhi, then proposed a vote of thanks.

ELEVENTH TECHNICAL CONVENTION

The Eleventh Technical Convention of the Institution of Telecommunication Engineers was held on the 9th (forenoon) and 10th December 1967 at the Constitution Club, New Delhi. Invitations were extended to research organizations in government departments, Council of Scientific & Industrial Research, industries, universities and public institutions in India to send papers for being presented at the Technical Convention. Invitations were also extended to similar organizations outside India. It is encouraging to record that 67 technical papers were received and 56 were read and discussed. Three sessions were arranged and papers grouped subjectwise to provide an opportunity for group discussion on specialized subjects.

First Session

The first session containing 15 papers dealt with Acoustics and Audio Engineering; Antenna and Propagation; Noise; Radio; Atmospheric; Cosmic, Galactic and Solar; Radio Astronomy; Radio Meteorology; Space Electronics; Navigational Electronics; Industrial Electronics; Electronic Computers and Control Engineering.

The session started with Shri S. Thiruvenkatachari, Additional Chief Engineer, All India Radio, New Delhi in the Chair who welcomed the participants and expressed his appreciation of the large number of papers being presented on many different subjects in the Technical Convention. In all fifteen papers were read and discussed. Details of the papers are given in Appendix IV—serials 1-15.

Second Session

The Second session of the Technical Convention was held on the 10 December 1967 when papers on Semiconductor Electronics; Materials and Components were read and discussed. Dr. N. B. Bhatt, Director, Solid State Physics Laboratory, Delhi, was the Chairman of the session. Papers read and discussed are given in Appendix IV—serials 16-30.

Third Session

The third and the last session of the technical convention was held on the 10th December, 1967 in the afternoon in which paper on Electrical Communication systems; Electronics instrumentation and control; LF, medium, HF, UHF, VHF and microwave techniques were presented and read.
