**ITEM-1 CONFIRMATION OF THE MINUTES OF THE 2ND (2015-16) MEETING OF THE
BOARD OF AWARDS HELD ON THE 09TH JULY 2016 AT IETE HQ**

1.1 As no comments were received, the minutes were confirmed.

ITEM-2 IETE AWARDS-2016

2.1 The Chairman informed the Board about the total number of 113 nominations was received in the year 2016 for all the Award categories. He also apprised the Members of the Board about the cut off dates for IETE Awards, i.e. for receipt of nominations: 15 June 2016 and for recommendations to be received from the expert jury, which was not fixed but IETE kept receiving them till 6th July 2016.

2.2 The Board scrutinized each nominations & recommendations received from the expert jury panel in each category. The nominations that received strong and unanimous support from the jurors were finally approved by the Board, but wherever the Board had some apprehension the nominations were discussed again. The credentials of the nominees were mapped and cross checked and finally the unanimity of the Board members prevailed in such cases.

2.3 The Chairman also informed the Board about the decision taken by the Search Committee meeting in IETE -Life Time Achievement Award & IETE Smt Triveni Devi Gupta Memorial Award 2016 on 8th July 2016. The names of the awardees are also included in the list appended below:-

ITEM-3 CORPUS FUND RECEIVED FOR IETE AWARDS

3.1 The Chairman apprised the Board that in case of **IETE-Bimal Bose Award**, where the corpus balance was coming in negative, an extra donation of Rs 5 lacs has been received from Prof Bimal Bose, Univ of Tennessee, Knoxville, USA, vide a cheque of US\$ 7353. He further announced that henceforth, this award will carry an increased cash award money of Rs 30,000/- instead of Rs 10,000/- and Travel Grant of Rs 5,000/- which was Rs 2,000/- earlier, as per the request of the donor himself.

3.2 In the second case of **IETE-Prof S N Mitra Memorial Award**, IETE received an extra corpus of Rs 1 lac from Shri Sunil Mitra, son of Prof S N Mitra, and as per the donor's request the travel subsidy in this case shall be increased from existing Rs 2000 to Rs 4000/- .

ITEM-4 LIST OF "EXTERNAL JURY OF EXPERTS" FOR IETE AWARDS

4.1 The Board was informed about the updated and modified expert jury panel. The Chairman said that the new jurors were approached after they concurred to be in the expert jury panel for three years. The Chairman also informed about their contribution in selection of awardees this year.

ITEM-5 IETE-NATIONAL TECHNICAL PAPER CONTEST(NTPC)-2016

5.1 Giving the background details for IETE-National Technical Paper Contest-2016, the Chairman apprised the Board about the hosting of NTPC-2016 by IETE Yavatmal Sub-Centre on 29th July 2016. He further said that as per the previous recommendations of the Governing Council taken during April 2015 Meeting that a token fees of Rs 300/-from ISF Members and Rs 500 from Non-ISF members should be charged. He clarified that though these instructions were not mentioned in the brochure, but after finding out from the Sub-Centre that there has been no registration till the date, it was thought that no fees charges be imposed on the students at least for this 2016 contest. However, the Chairperson clarified that the fee issues, whether to be charged or not, will be taken up as an agenda point in the next IETE Board of Awards Meeting.

5.2 It was also informed that IETE Yavatmal Sub-Centre had been given an advance of Rs 15,000/- on their request.

6.2 The Board was apprised about the suggestions given by Prof Dutta Roy that in the current scenario, the border lines between research orientation, application orientation and system orientation have almost vanished. Every research paper has to have a mix of all of these to get published. In IETE CDIL Award for Industry, the paper has to be from industry. Usually there is no worthwhile contribution from industry, so after writing to CDIL, this restriction may be removed. In IETE Gowri Memorial Award the award is given to the paper on topic of the general interest. Prof Dutta Roy says that generally a paper is focused on special topic, it is hard to find papers of general interest. Likewise the qualification for rest of the Best Paper Awards should also be omitted.

6.3 Prof Dutta Roy further suggests that IETE should merge these 6 Awards except the TWO Students' Journal Award category. These 6 awards can be for 6 best papers from IETEJR and IETETR. Every year a minimum of two awards for each journal should be made mandatory. The distribution could be 2-4, 3-3, or 4-2. The best papers can then be named for the type of the award according to its major orientation, as judged by a jury.

6.4 After due deliberation, it was acknowledged that though the suggestions given were valuable and even true in many instances, and may be taken up after systematic talks with the stakeholders, it was recommended that first relevant information be gathered before taking some steps in this direction.

6.5 This is for the information & approval of the Governing Council.

ITEM-9 LAPEL PINS




