**ITEM-1 CONFIRMATION OF THE MINUTES OF THE 2ND (2016-17) MEETING OF THE
BOARD OF AWARDS HELD ON THE 07 APRIL 2017 AT IIT KANPUR**

1.1 As no comments were received, the minutes were confirmed.

**ITEM-2 "CALL FOR NOMINATIONS" FOR IETE MAIN AWARDS AND IETE CORPORATE
AWARDS -2017**

2.1 The Chairman informed the members that 146 nominations had been received this year in various Award categories, which is the highest received so far. He also apprised the members about the extended cut off dates for receiving the nominations, *i.e.* 05 June 2017.

2.2 The Board scrutinized the nominations & the recommendations received in each category from the expert jury panel. The nominations that received unanimous support from the jurors were approved by the Board, but wherever the Board found only one or no responses, the results in those categories were deferred. It was recommended that the expert jury members of that Award category be approached once again and requested to send their recommendations for fair decision. The last date for receiving recommendations from jury members was decided to be 31 July 2017. Thereafter, these recommendations would be circulated for the information of

Board members for deciding the final awardee(s) in such cases. The final list of the awardees shall be hosted on the web after 10th Aug 2017.

2.3 The Chairman briefed the Board about the nominations that were eliminated (in bold) this year for not having met the given criteria.

- ❖ **Dr Goutam Chattopadhyay, NASA, Jet Propulsion Lab, USA**- The nominee had been awarded IETE Prof S N Mitra Memorial Award in 2013-14, whereas according to the criteria the nominee shouldn't have received any IETE Award during last three years. Hence his nomination was eliminated from IETE Ram Lal Wadhwa Award & IETE -IRSI (83) categories-2017.
- ❖ **Prof K P Ray, DIAT, Pune**- The nominee had been awarded IETE Ranjana Pal Memorial Award in 2013-14, whereas according to the criteria the nominee shouldn't have received any IETE Award during last three years. Hence his nomination was eliminated from IETE Ram Lal Wadhwa Award category-2017.
- ❖ **Dr B Nagaraj, Coimbatore & - Dr P Karthigai Kumar, Coimbatore**: These two nominees were nominated for IETE Biman Behari Sen Memorial Award-2017 by the same nominator- (Dr P Vijaya Kumar, Karpaggam, CoE, Coimbatore). Whereas according to the criteria one nominator should not nominate more than one nominee for the same IETE Award. To be fair and just, it was recommended that the first entry in the IETE desptach section would be considered, which was of Dr P Karthigai Kumar and second entry (Dr B Nagaraj, Coimbatore) will not be processed.
- ❖ **Dr Parul Puri, IIIT, Noida**- The nominee was nominated for Smt Manorama Rathore Memorial Award by Prof S C Saxena, VC, IIIT, Noida, who is an Expert Jury Member for IETE -R S Khandpur Award. According to the criteria members of Expert Jury panel cannot nominate individuals for IETE awards including IRSI Awards.
- ❖ **Dr Dipali R Shinde, AISSMS Institute of IT, Pune and- Ms Zaware, S Nitin, AISSMS Institute of IT**: These two nominees were nominated for IETE Technomedia Award for young women in Engineering by the same nominator Dr P Vijaya Kumar Mane, Karpaggam, CoE, Coimbatore. According to criteria one nominator should not nominate more than one nominee for the same IETE Award. To be fair and just, it was recommended that the nominator be approached and requested for more eligible nominee in this case. The said nominator recommended-Dr (Mrs) Sarika Nitin Zaware's name for this category vide his mail dated 14th June 2017.

2.4 The members deliberated on the nominations that were cancelled and it was decided that in future all nominations received from same nominator shall be cancelled and will not be sent for consideration for the jury members.

2.5 The Chairman also informed the Board about the decision taken for IETE-Life Time Achievement Award by the Search Committee that met on 08th July 2017 in the morning at 9.30 am.

7.1 Apprising the Board on the previous decision of Governing Council Meeting of 7th April 2017, taken at IIT Kanpur, the Chairman said that this new award - Shri P P Malhotra Memorial Award was decided to be allowed only for IETE Organizational members, as IETE does not have any award exclusive for this category and instituting an award in this direction could give IETE Org Members an opportunity to highlight their contribution in Innovation in the fields of electronics industry /academia.

This in turn would help IETE increase its Organizational membership base. Therefore, IETE-Shri P P Malhotra Memorial Award should be restricted to IETE Organizational Members category only.

7.4 The Chairman apprised the Board that Rs 3 lakhs as corpus money towards this award category had been received from Mrs P P Malhotra.


