The IETE President was in participation at the meeting and initiated the proceedings by warmly welcoming the Chairman and Members of the Board of Awards. He also urged all members to actively participate and contribute for a fruitful discussion.

The Chairman of the Board of Awards taking over extended a warm welcome to President IETE and all members of the BoA, and requested that the items on the agenda be discussed in the order they were listed.

ITEM-1 CONFIRMATION OF THE MINUTES OF THE 3RD (2023-24) MEETING OF THE BOARD OF AWARDS HELD ON THE 01 JULY 2024 AND SPECIAL MEETING ON 01 AUGUST 2024 THROUGH ZOOM

1.1 The Minutes of the 3rd (2023-24) BoA meeting were circulated. It was informed that no comments had been received. The Minutes were approved by the Board after addressing all the discussion points from previous meetings that remained unresolved, as pointed out in Item No 4.

ITEM-2 ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES AND WAY AHEAD FOR ACTIVITIES OF THE BOARD OF AWARDS

2.1 The roles, responsibilities and the activities of the BoA were informed to the Board Members.

a) Objectives:

- To oversee all matters related to the conferment of IETE awards.
- To institutionalize new awards and review existing ones.
- To ensure effective dissemination and publicity of awards.

b) Responsibilities:

1. Award Conferment:

- Oversee the selection process for IETE awards, ensuring transparency and fairness.
- Evaluate nominations and select awardees based on established criteria and guidelines.

2. Institutionalizing New Awards:

- Develop and propose new awards to recognize exceptional contributions and achievements in electronics and telecommunication.
- Establish criteria, eligibility, and procedures for new awards.

3. Review of Existing Awards:

- Periodically review current awards and their relevance to the institution's goals.
- Recommend modifications to existing awards or their criteria as needed to reflect current trends and achievements in the field.

4. Dissemination and Publicity:

- Develop and implement strategies for promoting awards and increasing their visibility.
- Coordinate with communication teams to ensure effective dissemination of award announcements and related information.
- Organize and oversee award ceremonies and related events.

5. Reporting:

- The BoA will report to the IETE Governing Council on its activities, decisions, and recommendations regarding awards and the corpus amount under each Award category.

2.2 The Chairman asked the members to comments on Terms of Reference (ToR) . No Comments were given.

2.3 **This is for the information of the Governing Council.**

ITEM-3 CONFERMENT OF AWARDS DURING AIC-2024

3.1 Members were apprised about the IETE Awards ceremony 2024 that took place in Bhopal on September 14-15, 2024, during which recipients were honoured with their awards. The medals and certificates for the awardees who were unable to attend the function were mailed to their mailing addresses.

3.2 It was also informed that in line with the practices of past years, the 2024 awardees were asked (through emails on 19-20 Nov 2024) to present a lecture on the work that led to their award at the nearest IETE Centre, with copies forwarded to the Chairmen of the concerned Centres nearest to the awardees' locations.

3.3 The details of the recipients who had already delivered their presentations and those who were working on them were presented to the Board. It was confirmed that appropriate follow-up will be done to ensure the awardees deliver their talks.

3.4 The Board was also informed that there had been a few international recipients in 2023-24. As part of their award, these persons are required to deliver a lecture or talk at the IETE event. It was put to the Board to figure out how and when they will be called to give their talk.

3.5 After due deliberations, the members unanimously recommended that

- a) The lectures of all the awardees ought to be documented and archived annually for future reference. These lectures shall remain available on the website for about a year and will be swapped with new award lecture later on.
- b) It is recommended that the foreign awardees be contacted to ascertain their willingness to deliver lectures or presentations. Upon agreement, the details may be disseminated to all Centres/ISFs, allowing interested Centres/ISFs to access the awardee's information and facilitate collaboration with the awardees for their presentations in close communication with IETE HQs.

3.6 This is for the information and approval of the Governing Council.

ITEM-4 POINTS FROM PREVIOUS MEETING FOR DISUCSSION

4.1 The following points from previous meeting were taken up for discussion:

- a) **Online Program/Software for Award Nominations-** The Board was informed that the software Kennovate, which was proposed by Dr. M H Kori the previous year, was not approved for use during the 2023-24 meetings due to the substantial annual licensing fee. Dr. Ajay Kumar, the Director of DTU and Co-Chair of the Board of Awards for 2023-24, offered his students' assistance in the development of the software at no cost for the IETE Awards. However, this initiative has not yet been realized. The issue was subsequently suggested to be brought to the attention of the President of IETE (2023-24), who may engage with Dr. Ajay Kumar regarding the matter. Nevertheless, the matter remains unresolved as of currently.
- b) **Corpus amount for new IETE Awards-** The Board was informed that the previous Board members had recommended that IETE establish three tiers, with values spanning from Rs 3 Lac to Rs 5 Lac, for the initiation of a new IETE Award as below:
 - (i) Rs 3 Lacs: Medal plus citation
 - (ii) Rs 4 Lacs: Plaque, Citation, and Medal
 - (iii) Rs 5 Lacs: Medal, Citation, Plaque & Travel Grant of Rs 10,000/-
- c) **Need for Jury Selection Process-** The Board was informed that, following earlier meetings, the previous Board had suggested the formation of a Sub-Committee to offer guidance on the jury selection process. The Sub-Committee will include the President, Vice Presidents, Immediate Past Presidents, and the Chair/Co-chair. The Committee was

unable get together last year due to several factors. As a result, this committee might consider proposing a method for the selection of the jury.

- d) **Naming of New IETE Awards:** It was informed that the previous Board had proposed that IETE develop explicit criteria for future award titles to uphold the integrity of the IETE awards. It was proposed that the suggested or appointed subcommittee be consulted upon receipt of any new award proposals.
- e) **Distinct proforma for each award:** The Board was informed that the Jury Prof Dutta Roy had recommended the development of a new proforma for each award, as the use of the same proforma for the majority of awards results in confusion. As per Prof. Roy, the nomination process ought to be simplified. He indicated that IETE might ask the Dy EICs for help, and he would then conduct a review. But when the IETE section asked Dy EIC about it, they said that the current one was good enough for now.
- f) **On difficulty of getting Jury Recommendations for each award annually on time:** The Board was informed that the IETE EIC JR, a jury member for various IEEE awards and a juror for several IETE awards, recently suggested that the IETE Board of Awards adopt the practice of inviting the jury to provide their recommendations for the selected awards online and participate in a real-time discussion with the BoA members. Every person must present a justification for their choice. The final name must then be decided by the Jury Head, President IETE, and Chairman IETE. It is possible to accept two to three award categories in one day. Following this, the 2nd level, IETE Governing Council/Authorities may analyze and approve on these recommendations. This approach would streamline the process of identifying the ultimate winner and making the selection online, accompanied by a justification for the choice. The selected name will be the definitive choice and cannot be challenged by anyone else. Prof Koul told that this procedure is carried out within IEEE, where he acts as a jury member for various awards.

4.1.1 The Board recommended the following for above issues:-

- a) **The members of the Board recommended that the section continue to pursue Dr Ajay Kumar, Dir DTU, and simultaneously approach Prof S L Kapoor, Prof AKGEC, Noida in order to put together the online program for IETE Awards, with the help of their students.**
- b) **The provision of three levels of seed funding for the establishment of a new IETE award was thoroughly analyzed. The Board members recommended that IETE pursue uniformity and standardization in award recognitions, given the prestigious nature of its awards. They also instructed that future award domains should remain distinct. The corpus fund for the establishment of a new IETE Award should be increased to a single higher level of 5 lacs in the future, rather than retaining three levels. Donors are likely to select only the lowest tier otherwise. It is advised to provide at least a medal, citation, and plaque, along with a travel grant equivalent to the round-trip fare of a two-tier train ticket for the awardee attending the event. Reimbursement will be provided equivalent to the fare of an A/C two-tier train, contingent upon the submission of travel tickets. Initially, it was proposed that all awards should be recognized equally. It was subsequently emphasized that this uniformity should specifically apply to the New Awards valued at 5 Lakhs.**

The accommodation payments are proposed to increase from Rs 2000 to Rs 3000/- for all awardees. IETE will reimburse each awardee Rs 3000 for accommodation; any extra expenses for more costly lodging will be the awardee's responsibility. Should an awardee need an accommodation or decide not to take one, it is essential that they notify IETE in advance. This will allow for their requests to be handled properly and for them to receive the necessary notifications.

- c) After thorough deliberation, the Board chose to maintain the current method of selecting jury members. It was stated that the jury may be proposed by any Board Member, G C Members, or any expert offering an alternative suggestion, which will ultimately receive approval from the GC Members, as per past practice.
- d) The Board deliberated for some time on naming of new IETE Awards and ultimately opted to maintain the status quo. They reasoned that, since donors often choose to honor family members/loved ones, it was best to leave it that way.
- e) On having a distinct proforma for each award category, after careful thought, members advised that there should not be any change made in the existing proforma.
- f) The Members proposed that, due to the confidential nature of IETE's jury recommendation, IETE should utilize a dependable and established method for acquiring these recommendations. Let it stay as it is, for even the jury on the panel is unaware of who the other jurors are in a category. Allow it to remain as it is.

ITEM-6 CALL FOR NOMINATIONS: FOR IETE MAIN AND IETE CORPORATE AWARDS-2025

6.1 The Board was apprised that the notice for “Call for Nominations” normally appears in the year end and beginning issues of **IETETR** and **IETEJR**. The updated Call for Nominations attached at (**Appendix “A”**) was for the consideration of the BoA members.

6.2 If the updated Call for Nominations is acceptable, it will be published in IETE Journals, posted on the website, and sent via email to all Centres, ISFs, PACs, Corporate Members, IITs, NITs, Engineering Colleges, DRDO, CSIR labs, and IETE Orgs members. Additionally, individual letters will be sent to all relevant organizations under the signature of the IETE President to ensure thorough publicity. Additionally, information regarding the announcement will be published on the IETE's Facebook page.

6.3 After careful consideration, the members recommended that it be published in the IETE Journals following the Governing Council's approval.

ITEM-7 TRAVEL GRANT IN IETE LIFE TIME ACHIEVEMENT AWARD

7.1 The Board was informed that the IETE-Lifetime Achievement Award includes an engraved silver plaque, a citation, and a travel grant of up to Rs.12,000/- or the actual air travel grant (to and fro) , whichever is less. If the recipient is local, local travel expenses are reimbursed.

7.2 However, the travel and accommodation facilities for the recipient(s) are covered by the IETE.

7.3 Following thorough deliberation, the board proposed that, given the significance of the Lifetime Award of IETE, a highly respected category that IETE has instituted, the travel grant should encompass Air Fare (Economy class) based on actual expenses, with IETE responsible for booking the tickets of the recipients. The IETE should also provide accommodation to the recipient. The limit on the 12,000/- travel grant in this category should be lifted. The Lifetime Achievement awardees were recommended to be kept at par with Distinguished Fellows for travel and Boarding /loading facilities. However, if the recipient is local, local travel expenses should be reimbursed.

7.4 This is for the approval of the Governing Council.

ITEM-8 JURY NAMES IN VARIOUS IETE AWARDS

8.1 The Members were given details regarding the required number of jurors in different categories (**Annexure “B”**) and were invited to propose new names, with a minimum of 5 and a maximum of 7, depending on the specialized area of the category.

8.2 This is for the approval of the Governing Council and the members may also like to suggest any names.

ITEM-9 SELECTION OF BEST PAPER AWARDEES

9.1 The Board members were informed of the challenge of selecting the best paper awardees by evaluating 800 to 900 articles per year by the EICs. It was proposed that they deliberate on an efficient method for selecting the most exceptional papers from IETE Journals.

9.2 The Members recommended that for IETE Best Paper Awardees selection IETE can apply the procedure as suggested by Prof Shibani Koul where IETE can call the EICs and Dy EICs physically for a meeting in IETE HQ to decide the Best paper awardees.

9.3 For the approval of the Governing Council Members.

ITEM-10 ANY OTHER MATTER WITH THE PERMISSION OF THE CHAIR.

10.1 The meeting ended with thanks to the Chair and President since there was no other point for discussions.

IETE MAIN AWARDS-2025: "CALL FOR NOMINATIONS"

Dear Sir/Madam,

The Institution of Electronics and Telecommunications Engineers (IETE) is a leading professional society dedicated to the advancement of science and technology in the fields of electronics, telecommunications, information technology, computer science, and other related disciplines. Through its prestigious annual / biennial awards, IETE recognises outstanding contributions made by scientists and engineers in a variety of fields within the domain of IETE. These awards are presented each September during the Annual IETE Convention (AIC).

2. The process of IETE awards begins with the publication of a "Call for Nominations" every year. The nominees need not be IETE members except for a few awards, such as the IETE–B R Batra Memorial Award (Sl.No.2.13 of the enclosed brochure), the IETE–Technomedia Award for Young Women in Engineering (Sl.No. 2.21 of the enclosed brochure), and the IETE–Shri P P Malhotra Memorial Award (Sl.No.2.23 of the enclosed brochure).

3. You are invited to send nominations or nominate deserving individuals for the IETE awards and assist us in identifying deserving individuals in the various awards categories. **The IETE award nomination forms are available on the IETE website at <http://www.iete.org>.**

4. The following details should be kept in mind when submitting nominations:-

- (a) One nominator should not nominate more than one nominee **for the same IETE award**. However, one nominator can nominate more than one nominee **for different IETE awards**.
- (b) Members of "**External Jury of Experts**" and the "**Board of Awards**" cannot nominate individuals for any IETE award. These members cannot be a nominee also.
- (c) Both nominator and nominee should ensure that the work of the nominee is as per the field mentioned in the description of IETE award for which he / she is being nominated.
- (d) The nominee should not have previously received any national or international recognition for that work. Additionally, the nominee should not have received an IETE award in the preceding three years.
- (e) The upper age limit for IETE-IRSI (83) Young Scientist Award (Sl. No.2.5 (b) of enclosed brochure) is 35 years; for IETE Technomedia Award for Young Women in Engineering (Sl No 2.21 of enclosed annexure) is 50 years; the age criteria for Life Time Achievement Award is 65 years or above (Sl No 2.17 of enclosed brochure) and the age limit for the IETE – Sri C Viswanatha Reddy Memorial Award is under 35 year (Sl No 2.25 of enclosed brochure).
- (f) A single person can only be nominated for two categories in a calendar year.
- (g) One nominee shall not be given more than one IETE Award in a year.

5. Nominations are required to be sent in form of a soft copy in PDF format via email or CD/pendrive, as per the prescribed proforma, duly completed in all respects with all required documents and signed digitally by the nominator as well as the nominee, to the Chairman, Board of Awards (BoA), no later than **May 31, 2025**.

IETE MAIN AWARDS

The Institution of Electronics and Telecommunications Engineers (IETE) recognises outstanding achievements among its members and other professionals in the broad fields of electronics, telecommunications, computers, information technology, and related disciplines through its prestigious annual/biennial awards. This Annexure contains a list of Awards that has been updated for the year **2025**, along with their descriptions, previous recipients' names (www.iete.org), nomination criteria, and procedure. Each year, nominations for these awards are invited in the prescribed enclosed proforma for consideration by the IETE-Board of Awards.

2. DESCRIPTION OF AWARDS:

2.1 IETE - Ram Lal Wadhwa Award (2025)

This award has been instituted through donation made by Dr R P Wadhwa, Fellow IETE, in memory of his father. The award is given to a person for **outstanding original contribution in the field of electronics and telecommunication engineering during the last 10 (ten) years**. The Institution of Electronics and Telecommunication Engineers has instituted a total eight Corporate Awards, one in each of the four areas of Electronic Components, Computer & Telecommunication Systems, Development of Software and Electronic Instruments & Instrumentation, separately for Large Enterprises (LEs) and Micro/Small/ Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) for recognising performance excellence of the Corporate Sector (Establishment / Organization / Service entrepreneur / Industry). Description, eligibility, nomination criteria & procedure and evaluation process for these awards are outlined in this brochure. Nominations are invited every year for these awards by 31st of May in the prescribed proforma for consideration by the IETE. "Call for Nominations" is also published in year end and beginning issues of 'IETE Journal of Research' and 'IETE Technical Review' and is also uploaded on IETE website: <http://www.iete.org>. Each award consists of a citation and a memento. Awards are presented at Annual IETE Convention held every year in the second half of September.

2. DESCRIPTION OF AWARDS:

- (a) **IETE-Corporate Award for Performance in Electronic Components** for excellence in engineering, manufacturing, exports, R&D efforts and their commercial deployment, optimum utilization of appropriate technologies and management practices or other initiatives, that have resulted in accelerated growth in the country in the field of **Electronic Components** for the last 3 (three) years.
- (b) **IETE-Corporate Award for Performance in Computer & Telecommunication Systems** for excellence in engineering, manufacturing, export, R & D efforts and their commercial deployment, optimum utilization of appropriate technologies and management practices or other initiatives, that have resulted in accelerated growth in the country in the field of **Computer and Telecommunication Systems** for the last 3 (three) years.
- (c) **IETE-Corporate Award for Performance in Development of Software** for recognition of outstanding performance and growth rates achieved by an establishment/organisation/service entrepreneur/industry in the field of **Development of Software** in the country during the last 3 (three) years through excellence in engineering problems & writing software solutions, optimum utilization of resources, sound management practices and other initiatives.
- (d) **IETE Corporate Award for Performance in Electronic Instruments and Instrumentation** for excellence in engineering, manufacturing, exports, R&D efforts and their commercial deployment, optimum utilization of appropriate technologies and management practices or other initiatives, that have resulted in accelerated growth in the country in the field of **Electronic Instruments and Instrumentation** for the last 3 (three) years.

3. ELIGIBILITY:

The above awards are open to Institutions, Establishments, Service Entrepreneurs, Corporations and Organizations registered in India. One nominee is eligible to apply for only one award in a year.

4. NOMINATION CRITERIA:

The main criteria for nomination and evaluation will be: excellence in engineering, outstanding growth rates in manufacturing, exports, R&D efforts and their commercial deployment, optimum utilization of appropriate technologies and management practices or other initiatives that have resulted in accelerated growth in the country in the above mentioned fields over the past three years. The nominee should not have received any award for that work / performance earlier. Also, the nominee should not have received any of the IETE Corporate Awards during the last 3 years.

5. **EVALUATION PROCESS:**

The nominations received are referred to the “External Jury Experts” in the respective field for evaluation. ‘Selection of awardees’ is based on the assessment of the members of the “External Jury” and recommendations of members of the “Board of Awards” for approval of the Governing Council of IETE. The awardee for each award is selected on merit basis as per the standard laid down procedure. The decision of IETE Governing Council is final and binding on all.

6. **NOMINATION PROCEDURE AND SUBMISSION:**

- Nominations are to be made by the Proprietor / Chairman / Managing Director / Director / General Manager of the organization.
- Nominations should be made only in the prescribed Nomination Form available on IETE **website: <http://www.iete.org>**, freely downloadable and all the statements must be **concise and confined to the allotted space only**.
- A nominee / organization is ineligible if received any of IETE-Corporate awards during the last three years.
- A soft copy of the nomination (font size 10) in PDF format or on a Pen Drive/CD as per prescribed proforma duly filled-in by the Proprietor / Chairman / Managing Director / Director / General Manager of the concerned enterprise may be sent to the following address/ email ID, to reach the Chairman, BoA by **May 31, 2025** at the latest. **Nominations that are incomplete will not be considered.**
