2.1 Four IETE – BSNL Awards

IETE-BSNL, 3 Awards viz excellence in Marketing, excellence in Finance and excellence in operation and maintenance were approved by the Board earliest. Now BSNL has added one more award and asked for the following to be included in selection procedure of IETE:-

- Selection Committee should comprise of 4 members, two each from BSNL & IETE.
 - The selection committee will change every year.
- In view of the suggested changes, IETE –Board of Recognition needs time to reconsider IETE-BSNL awards as no sponsors of awards have ever been in the selection committee earlier.


ITEM-3 UPDATION OF IETE AWARDS NOMINATION PERFORMANCE

- 3.1 The Board considered the changes in selection criteria of IETE awards projected by Managing Editor and finalized them to ensure that one nominator does not nominate more than one nominee for IETE-Awards and nominee's work matches the description of award. Also one nominee does not figure in more than one award in a year. The nominee and nominator have to give a certificate that their work for the proposed IETE award being sought has not been awarded earlier by any national or international agency. The forwarding letter and brochure for IETE main awards approved in this meeting is placed at Annexure-I.
- 3.2 The Board approved the need to simplify the proforma for nomination of main awards. Lt Gen Davinder Kumar has volunteered to simplify the main award proforma. Also Dr Asha Goyal has agreed to draft suggested changes to include small scale units in IETE-Corporate awards nomination proforma. She would also suggest the necessary changes that are required to include the preference to be given to handicapped persons in selection criteria / procedure.
- 3.3 The Board decided to retain the National Technical Paper contest in its present form. However, they decided that the prize money for the 3 prizes viz 1st Prize, 2nd Prize and 3rd Prize, in the order of merit, may be increased to Rs 5,000, Rs 3,000 and Rs 2,000 respectively. Invitation poster as approved by the committee is at Annexure-II.

ITEM-4 FUTURE ACTIVITIES OF THE BOARD OF RECOGNITION OF EXCELLENCE

- 4.1 The Board proposes to undertake grading of engineering Institutions in India. For this purpose IETE centers will be asked to undertake the task in their geographical area. Work done in this regards will add up to the performance of the center for IETE Best center award.
- 4.2 Dr (Mrs) Asha Goyal proposed that the acronym of the Board be changed from BORE TO REB.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the chair.

The award consists of a gold medal, a citation, a cash prize of Rs 10,000/- and a travel grant of up to a maximum of Rs 7,000/-. The recipient is invited to deliver a lecture on the work leading to award on a suitable occasion at the IETE centre nearest to the location of awardee. The award will be given for the first time in the year 2006.

SELECTION CRITERIA

- The awards are generally open to Indian nationals for their work done in India.
- While there is no age limit for these awards, preference will be given to nominees below 45 years of age.
- The contributions and achievements of the nominee should have the potential of significant impact on the future developments in India in the respective fields recognized for the award.
- The contributions and achievements of the nominee should be properly documented and be verifiable.
- The nominee should have demonstrated potential for creative output **and should not have received an award for that work earlier.**
- No self nomination will be considered.
- Sitting Council Members are not eligible for any IETE Awards.
- One nomination only in a year by a nominator is admissible **for IETE Awards.**
- **Only one nomination of a nominee is admissible in a year for IETE Awards.**

NOMINATION PROCEDURE

- Nominations for the awards can be made by Heads of Academic / Scientific Institutions, R&D Labs / Establishments of CSIR / DRDO / ISRO / DOT/ MIT etc, major industries both public and private, like BEL / ITI / HAL / ECIL / Tata Electric, Kirloskar Electric, WIPRO, HCL etc, Indian Army/Navy/ Air Force, Service Organisations like State Electricity Boards, Indian Airlines, Air India, other agencies/centres like BIS, STQC, other Professional Societies, Organisational Members, Past Presidents, Distinguished Fellows, Council Members of IETE and Fellows of IETE with a standing of 5 years or above.
- Nominations should be made only in the prescribed Nomination Form enclosed with this brochure (or its photocopy) and all the statements have to be concise and confined to the allotted space only.
- A proposed citation (limited to 50 words) should be included in the Nomination Form at the appropriate place. Absence of this citation may disqualify the nomination.
- The Nomination Form **15 copies** typed in 10 pt or larger font and completed in all respects together with a list of scientific and technical publications if any, should be sent in a sealed cover marked "**confidential**" at the following address. Incomplete nominations will not be considered.

- 1. FORMAT:** The paper should be written in English by not more than two authors. The length of the paper should be limited to 3000 words (about 8 to 9 pages including figures) and neatly typed in A4 size paper on one side only with double space and wide margin.
- 2. SUBMISSION OF PAPER:** Three copies to be submitted. In the case of BE/ B.Tech/ B.Sc. (Engg) students, the paper should be accompanied by a bona fide certificate of studentship issued by the head of the department / institution, where the student is enrolled, clearly indicating the class and the branch of study and endorsing the student's authorship of the paper. The certificate should also include a declaration that the paper has not been published or presented for publication in any magazine or journal, nor has it been published or accepted for presentation in any symposium or conference during the period of its consideration by IETE. In the case of IETE student members, the membership number should be certified by an IETE Council Member or a Chairman of IETE Local Centre / Sub-Centre. The paper is liable to be disqualified in the absence of this certificate. The authors are to write clearly their postal address, telephone No., fax No. and e-mail address. Also they are to subscribe on the top of envelop, "IETE-NATIONAL TECHNICAL PAPER CONTEST 2006".
