ITEM-5 EXISTING NOMINATION CRITERIA

5.1 The Chair stated that there has been no mention of sitting IETE Governing Council members to be or not to be an expert jury for any of the awards in the nomination criteria. Also, if any of the expert jury members could be nominated for any of the IETE awards, other than that in which he/she is in the panel as expert jury. He asked the Board's for their opinion on this.

5.2 After due deliberations the Board recommended the following guidelines to be incorporated in Nomination criteria / Guidelines for Call for Nominations, with immediate effect.

- The sitting Governing Council Members should not be a member of the external "Jury of experts".
- A sitting Jury Member is not eligible for any Award.
- No correspondence/ arguments will be entertained once the results for awards are declared by the Board. The final decision will be of the BoRE.
- The Members also recommended that the sitting Jury Members should be felicitated with some token of gratitude, like shawl or any good memento.

5.3 This is for the approval of the Governing Council.

ITEM-6 REVIEW OF EXISTING AWARDS AND CORPUS REQUIRED FOR INSTITUTING NEW IETE AWARD & STANDARDIZING THE AWARD.

6.1 The Chair stated that the issue of finalizing minimum corpus fund for instituting new awards could not be discussed during 1st and 2nd (2014-15) meeting of BoRE. Therefore, this issue needs further deliberation and finalization.

6.2 He also informed that a cheque of Rs 3 lakhs from Shri R K Tyagi has been received for instituting three awards with corpus of Rs 1 lac each. The members were requested for their opinion on the issue. After due deliberations Board recommended following:-

- No retrospective look for the existing awards. Decisions taken will be applicable only to the newly instituted awards.
- The corpus amount for instituting any new award will be Rs 3 lacs.
- The newly instituted awards shall consist of a Medal, a Citation & a Plaque and a travel grant of maximum Rs 3000.
- Only one award shall be instituted by one donor.

- Corpus fund should be kept in fixed deposit in one of the National Banks and under no circumstances the corpus fund should be spent and only interest accrued on it is to be utilized for the expenditure for the awards.
