Past two years have been growth oriented and highly rewarding for the institution. We commenced year-round Golden Jubilee celebrations in Oct 2002 and increased the visibility of IETE by conducting symposia, seminars, workshops and lectures. We conducted as many as 42 major functions during 2002-04. The number of IETE centres

rose to 50 from 42, in January 2004. Membership and ISF activities too, registered substantial increase.

Our primary task is a commitment for human resource development in electronics, telecommunication, computer science and information technology, which we have been undertaking through our examination system. We have done a commendable job in our research programme. Today, we have two IETE Research scholars working at our premier institutions in emerging fields of wireless and microwave & radar technologies. IETE Research scholar at IIT Delhi is working on 'Millimetre Wave Integrated Circuits Using Non-Radiative Dielectric Waveguide Technology for Radar Applications'. The work done by him has been accepted for publication in "Microwave and Optical Technology Letters", USA. Another IETE research scholar from IIT, Madras is working on "Channel Estimation and Signal Processing for MIMO-OFDM and MC-CDMA Wireless Communications Systems". His work has been accepted for publication in IEEE Signal Processing letters.

We are now pursuing IETE e-learning programme, which has always been on my priority list. The beginning has been made but we have to go a long way before it is implemented. We have to first create contents for each subject in IETE syllabi and then acquire the infrastructure for its delivery. This requirement assumes the highest priority as e-learning is necessary for taking quality education to the villages and remote areas where majority of our people live. The real economic development and growth of our nation is dependent on uprooting the illiteracy from every nook and corner of India.

Lastly, I would like to thank members: Corporate, Student and Organizational for their selfless service to the IETE, which has been my source of strength throughout.

nwards the growth of local / sub-centres, examination eforms, membership growth, students' interactive forums and conal coordination activities of IETE.





IETE APEX FORUM

"Broadband- The Answer to ICT Development" we the topic of the IETE Apex Forum on July 10, 2004 at IET HQ. Lt Gen (Retd) D P Sehgal, PVSM, AVSM, VSM Chairman Industrial Coordination Committee welcomed the congregation and Shri P N Chopra, DIG BSF (Retd.)

Convenor of the forum introduced and justified the theme of the topic. 'Broadband is being seen as a media of the lature. There are unlimited avenues in which broad band ervices are going to open up different ICT applications such in the area of entertainment, marketing, freight logistics, ansportation, healthcare, tele medicine, financial services, beque transaction, tourism, e-governance, etc' said Shri P Chopra, in his introductory speech. He expected a boom the growth of broadband services similar to the mobile tephony.

The Chief Guest, Shri S Lakshminarayanan, IAS, ighlighted the importance of Broadband in the delivery of ICT or economic development and growth. He gave an overview of Government's plan and targets for increasing broadband occess. He praised engineers both in Govt and private sector for increasing the teledensity of the country ahead of the planned target dates.

Shri S Lakshminarayanan released the Proceedings of Optimal Utilization of Frequency Spectrum" previously held ETE Apex Forum.

The panelists who presented their views were Shri R N Agarwal, Former Wireless Advisor, Govt of India, Shri A S Guin, Chief Engineer, Doordarshan, Shri S N Gupta, Advisor TRAI, Shri M Shanmugham, Director All India Radio, Dr Rakesh Mehrotra, Managing Director, Zee TeleFilms and Shri P K Garg Wireless Advisor to the Govt of India.

Shri R N Agarwal, in his address called ICT as the barometer of socio-economic development of society. He said that it was the right time for India to have appropriate penetration of broadband services. He talked about the different facets, applications, affordability, quality of services etc. According to him there should be flexibility in the approach for utilizing different frequency bands for different services.

Shri A S Guin spoke on Broadband & IT in Broadcasting. He talked about the importance of broadband services and its use for TV, HiFi distribution, video retrieval, data transfer services etc. He described one-way and two-way transport systems, limitations and advantages of broadband through wireless, DTT, DTH, DRM, DAB and Cable Satellite.

Shri S N Gupta addressed the emerging trends in ICT and deregulation. Starting with the development trends, he covered evolution of VoIP, last mile technologies, shift from fixed to mobile access, mobile technology trend, convergence, spectrum utilization and telecom deregulation.

Shri Rakesh Mehrotra from Zee Telefilms said that broadband should be for masses and not for only elite. He described it's utility in Indian environment and acceptance of western or Indian model. Talking of communication and development of economy in rural India he said everything is doable. He suggested that we should understand the importance of broadband for rural masses, eliminate artificial cost, be technology neutral, convert village PCO's into community commercial hubs, involve NGOs, learn to use TV for delivery of ICT and then finally migrate to TV based ICT services.

Dr Shanmugam's talk centered around Broadband & Broadcasting. The impact of Broadband on broadcasting and its access application, was highlighted.

With the availability of global connection, increased teledensity, mobile telephony, growth of Internet, increased data traffic, broadband is required, which is a faster communication channel said Shri Garg. He also said that many social problems might crop up if technologies are not brought to the rural areas. He favoured the judicious mix of wireless and wireline technologies, wise use of limited spectrum, development of proper contents, traffic affordability before spreading the broadband technologies. He strongly believed that delicensing of the spectrum is not the solution, as the delicensed band cannot be extensively used.

Prof K K Aggarwal, President, IETE summed up the views presented by the panelists. He said broadband is necessary to take ICT to remote, rural and even to urban areas. ICTs are the necessary tool for desired economic growth of people living in every part of our country.
