NEWS FROM HEADQUARTERS

Report on 43rd Annual Technical Convention-ATC 2000

The 43rd Annual Technical Convention of IETE was held from 30th Sep to 1st Oct 2000 at India Habitat Centre, New Delhi on an apt subject "e-Commerce".

The Convention was inaugurated by Shri Arun Jaitley, Hon'ble Minister of Information and Broadcasting and Law, Justice and Company Affairs. He laid stress on the relevance of Internet and e-commerce to our country and said that the world had started recognizing India as a powerful and potent economic force because of its knowledge resource. established our identity atleast in one area of core competence. He said that IT act, which was passed by the Parliament, was a firm step but has limitations of enacting cyber laws and regulations. It recognizes e-commerce, e-records, e-documents, e-signatures and creates certain categories of electronic offences and makes people accountable for these offences. We will have to keep pace with the technology and legislate in order to create a framework under which the Govt acts as a facilitator for the e-commerce to grow.

The inaugural session of the Convention included announcement of

Honorary Fellowship of the Institution to Shri Azim H Premji, Chairman WIPRO, and Conferment of Distinguished Fellowship on Dr Surendra Pal, Group Director, ISRO, Bangalore.

The Chief Guest released a souvenir on the occasion along with e-commerce special issue of IETE Technical Review. The mementoes were presented to the Honourable Guests.

Maj Gen Yashwant Deva, AVSM (Retd) who assumed the office of President, IETE at the Convention, emphasized on policy making issues and creation of infrastructure for pursuing the applied research. He said "Here (in India), the conflict is and shall always be between hierarchies that smack of and betray totalitarianism, babuism, and fundamentalism on one side of the divide and networks borne of liberalism, egalitarianism and pluralism on the other. It is not that network cannot be an instrument of infraction and libertine and permissive culture as is apparent from the Internet. However, evil is in content not in connectivity, in application not in design".

The inaugural session also featured the 32nd Bhabha Memorial Lecture by Dr V K Aatre, SA to Raksha Mantri and Secretary, DRDO on "Electronic-Warfare- A Perspective". Dr Aatre explained how electronics can act as a force multiplier in war. Among other eminent speakers in the inaugural session were Shri N Vittal,

Chief Vigilance Commissioner, who in his lead talk emphasized on developing the imperatives for the success of e-commerce namely computer density, connectivity, content, cyber laws. He advocated tax holiday for the articles traded through e-commerce.

Some of the recommendations made by the experts were:

- · Deployment of national Internet back bone.
- Installation of payment gateways that connect all banks.
- Development of healthy IT culture in business and organisation.
- Installation of security systems.
- Setting up of the data bases on the lines of Sweden and Singapore.
- Creation of Digital Certification authorities
- Declaration of cyber Space as the common heritage of mankind by the UN General Assembly.
- Adoption of ADSSL and WAP technologies which

help in broad-band Internet Communication.

• Statutory security audit.

On the 2nd day of the Technical Convention Dr K N Shankara, Deputy Director, ISRO, Bangalore delivered the 23rd Ram Lal Wadhwa Memorial Award Lecture on "Indigenisation of critical Technologies Communication Satellites". He highlighted the steps taken by the Indian Scientists after impositions of sanctions in 1998. Important tasks undertaken under this programme are Development of Space qualified TWTA (jointly with CEERI, Pilani and Bharat Electronics), Development of GaAs Solar Cells, at IISc, Bangalore, Development of GaAs power FETS at CEERI, Development of TCXO's, Zener Dioder, Switching Diode, RF connectors, EMI filters, Linear ICs etc. Some of these indigenous efforts have been completed and others are progressing well. He revealed that India's first GSLV was scheduled for launch in the year 2001.

Tutorials on e-commerce and Internet & IT enabled Services were conducted before the inaugural session on 29th Sep 2000. The tutorials were well attended by the practicing managers, engineers and students from all over India.

SummIT 2000

A Mega International Show and Business SummIT 2000 was held at Kathmandu from Sept 9-11, 2000. The SAARC, SEARCC, CJK, GULF and Western countries participated. Dr H S Sharma made a presentation in the Summit on "IT as a tool for Social, Cultural and Economic Development".

SEARCC News

Brig SVS Chowdhry, Past President and Distinguished Fellow of the IETE attended SEARCC meeting in Cebu, Phillipines on 27 May 2000 along with Dr R Srinivasan, FIETE.

SEARCC is a grouping of 14 countries with the avowed aim of promoting regional co-operation in the field of IT. India is an active member of this group and has hosted the SEARCC Conferences in the past, in 1988 and 1997.



With the cable networks going digital and using data compression techniques, this is now feasible.

All the major firms like Incable Net, Zee TV's proposed CATV network, Hathnay, Dishnet DSL and some more are entering this field. DeskTop TV connecting boxes for use on cable for this purpose have been developed. Silicon Mountains and Pune Association of cable operators are launching Internet services on its hybrid fibre optic/coaxial cable networks.
